IN FRANCE DEATH TOLL FOR COVID-19 HAS SURPASSED 3,000 & 5,056 IN INTENSIVE CARE

16,924 RECOVERED LEFT HOSPITAL

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USPA NEWS - As every evening, Jerome Salomon, Director General of the Ministry of Health announced the death toll in France, which is increasing with deaths due to COVID-19 as well as infected patients, as well as those who have recovered. What to remember from the daily press point at 7 p.m. France has thus crossed the threshold of 3,000 deaths in hospital with 3,024 victims. Ile De France (Paris and Suburbs) and Grand East are still the hotspots for the COVID-19. These figures do not include the deaths of the elderly, who die at home, or in retirement homes "Not all the data are according to data compiled yet in order to declare the overall number fatalities reflecting the real death toll. 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In his daily press briefing, Jerome Salomon, the Director General of Health, indicated that 16,924 people have "left healed" from the hospital since March 1. "34% of patients hospitalized in intensive care are less than 60 years old" and 59% are between 60 and 80 years old, he said. 64 people in intensive care are under 30 years old. This Monday, March 30, 5,056 people are on intensive care, or 424 more in 24 hours. IN FRANCE 10 MILLION FACE MASKS ARRIVING FROM CHINA BY AIRCRAFT-----

Meanwhile, doctors and health care workers across the country have warned of dangerous shortages in essential medical equipment such as beds equipped with ventilators, and protective gear such as masks, gowns, gloves, and more in intensive care units. As a response to this call, there are 10 million masks from China arrived in France by air today, following the pleas of doctors and medical teams as well as other professions such as police, firefighters, prison guards and supermarket cashiers. While 74 million FFP2 masks have been ordered by France in total, some 10 million finally arrived this Monday, March 30 at Vatry airport, in the Marne. Knowing that the Minister of Health Olivier Veran has declared to have "ordered 1 Billion masks around the world". The Antonov 124 plane arrived at Paris-Vatry at 2:15 p.m., with goods on board from China on board. This air bridge between France and China will continue for 14 weeks. Unloading millions of masks must take two hours. According to information from France 3-Grand Est, as soon as planes are landed, the packages will be loaded on trucks to head for the four corners of France.
