Jean-Christophe Fromantin and Pascal Lamy reiterated the strong national mobilization around this project, orchestrated by EXPOFRANCE 2025, an association, state, local communities, business partners, and having already attracted the membership of more than one hundred thousand French in a support committee. They said the work on the different components of the application, mainly the application configuration around the Global Village and theme sections.
